Located in the heart of the Beaujolais wine region, this historical monument opened its doors as a hotel-restaurant in 1992. With at least one staff member per guest, a majestic gourmet dining room, and impeccable attention to detail, Château de Bagnols is regarded as one of the world's finest vineyard chateau-hotels.
