

Masseria San Domenico

PUGLIA, ITALY – Set in Brindisi in the Puglia region along Italy's Adriatic coast, Masseria San Domenico stands amid acres of vibrant orchards and olive groves. Originally built as a watchtower by the Knights of Malta in the 15th century, the property has been meticulously restored, and it opened its doors as a charming, boutique-style resort in 1996. Guests can play a round on the challenging 18-hole golf course, cool off in the stunning seawater pool, or visit the spa for a Thalassotherapy treatment, which draws upon the healing powers of seawater. A nearby beach is reserved exclusively for hotel guests and includes an elegant restaurant, bar and lounge. Five additional on-site dining and cocktail venues offer unique atmospheres for high-end dining or casual outdoor relaxation.
