The seven-building, 13th-century complex offers novelty even to the repeat guest. Each of the 101 bedrooms and suites showcases distinctive architecture and design inspired by 1930's Czech cubism. The hotel's restaurant and bars attract visitors as well as locals, who enjoy home-brewed beer and dining in the glass-enclosed courtyard.
